Use this application to apply for a tow truck operator licence.

How to apply

First, you need to work out what category of licence you will need to apply for. Different types of work will require a different licence.

- Category A (4-digit TT plates) Accident and breakdown/trade tow
- Category B (3-digit TT plates) Breakdown/trade tow
- Category B-Restricted (3-digit TT plates)

You do not need a Tow Truck Operator Licence if you are towing, salvaging or storing certain exempted vehicles and trailers. A full list of all exempted vehicles can be found on the Fair Trading website.
