

To be issued with a certificate you must prove you are a suitable person to be the driver of a tow truck. To do this you will need to provide the following documents with your application: ☐ A photocopy of your current, unrestricted Australian driver licence (front and back) ☐ If you held a driver licence from another Australian State or Territory or from overseas within the past 3 years, you must provide an original statement of your driver licence details AND traffic history issued from the relevant licensing authority in that jurisdiction for that period ☐ Two recent passport size and quality photographs of your head and neck (no hat or sunglasses on a pale background). We recommend you get your photo taken at your local Australia Post Office ☐ Interstate/Overseas criminal history and traffic record if applicable (refer to SECTION 4) ☐ Your driving record will also be checked. ☐ Correct payment and receipt number as below **Payment** A fee must be paid on lodgement of the application form. Step 1 – Click on the link or type the URL into your web browser Step 2 - Follow the instructions online to complete the payment Step 3 – When the lodgement fee is paid online you will receive a receipt number. Privacy Collection Notice

The Department of Customer Service on behalf of the Commissioner for Fair Trading (NSW Fair Trading), gives priority to protecting the privacy of your personal information. We may also use it to administer/update our customer database including to send you information that we consider important such as reminders to renew licences.

We will store and manage your personal information in accordance with provisions under the PPIP Act.

If required, we may make enquiries and exchange information with other NSW government agencies (including the NSW Police Force), other States and Territories, the Commonwealth and/or New Zealand for the purpose of assessing your application and for compliance purposes. We may disclose your personal information for these purposes.

We will not disclose your personal information to anybody else unless you have given consent, or we are authorised or permitted to do so by law.
